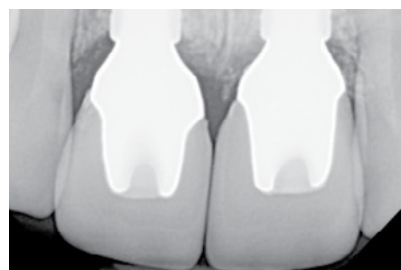

Predictable Implant Aesthetics
